Located in the commune of Quincié, on west-facing slopes

Soil:

Granite and disintegrated schist

Grape Variety:

Gamay

Vinification:

Manual harvesting, maceration of grapes in tanks

Tasting Notes:

Dressed in crimson velvet with a fruity bouquet reminiscent of blackcurrant jam. Round and supple in the mouth, this wine reveals silky tannins with a beautiful aromatic persistence

Pairing Suggestions:

It goes well with all roasted poultry, braised beef or a Charolais entrecote.
