Granitic sand, quartz crystals

Gamay

Vinification:

Manual harvesting, maceration of grapes in tanks

Tasting Notes:

Garnet ruby color, nose with floral aromas of peony, rose nuanced with spicy notes. The mouth is structured and fine, spicy, full-bodied for a peppery finish.

Pairing Suggestions:

Deli meats, white meats, grills, world cuisine (Tajine, Couscous, Paëlla). Soft cheese.
