Located in the south of the Morgon cru, at the bottom of the Morgon hamlet.

Soil :

Granite and altered schists

Grape Variety :

Gamay

Color :

Red

Alcohol :

13 % vol.

Vinification :

Manual harvesting, maceration of grapes in tanks

Tasting Notes :

A beautiful purple color, it gives off aromas of violet and red fruits. On the palate, it is full-bodied, fleshy and generous, typical of the Cru Morgon, earning it the the expression 'Morgonner'.

Pairing Suggestions :

Roasted game, poultry and red meat. As it ages, it goes very well with soft cheeses (Epoisse, Brillat-Savarin).
